

Six days of  
Creation ...

*... in six days the LORD made the heavens,  
the earth, the sea, and everything in them*  
Exodus 20: 11

## SIX DAYS OF CREATION

### Genesis 1:1 - 2:3

*In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth(?1)*

*... God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ... he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day" and the darkness "night." Together these made up one day. (the first day) (?2)*

*And God said, "Let there be space between the waters, to separate water from water." ... And God called the space "sky." This happened on the second day. (?3)*

*(Then God spoke and he made the dry ground appear which he called land and he gathered the waters into one place which he called seas. He also created all the plants and trees which have seeds and seed-bearing fruit. These seeds will then produce more plants of the same kind.) ... God saw that it was good. This all happened on the third day.*

*And God said, "Let bright lights appear in the sky to separate the day from the night. ... God made two great lights, the sun and the moon, to shine down upon the earth. ... He also made the stars. ... And God saw that it was good. This all happened on the fourth day.*

*And God said, "Let the waters swarm with fish and other life. Let the skies be filled with birds of every kind." ... This all happened on the fifth day.*

*And God said, "Let the earth bring forth every kind of animal--livestock, small animals, and wildlife." And so it was. ... Then God said, "Let us make people in our image, to be like ourselves. They will be masters over all life--the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the livestock, wild animals, and small animals." So God created people*

*in his own image; God patterned them after himself; male and female he created them. ... Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was excellent in every way. This all happened on the sixth day. (?4)*

*So the creation of the heavens and the earth and everything in them was completed. On the seventh day, having finished his task, God rested from all his work. And God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy, because it was the day when he rested from his work of creation. (?5)*
